Preparation of a New Church Electoral Roll

The church electoral roll is a list of those who eligible to attend and vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting and stand for election on the Parochial Church Council. It is an indication of the real membership of the church. Enrolment is a way of saying "I belong" Once every six years the preparation of a new Electoral Roll takes place, which means that everybody has to come off and re-apply **otherwise their names will be deleted**.

Everyone on the current roll is being invited to re-apply for inclusion on the new roll. Letters and forms are available in each church. Large print forms are available.

There are spare forms available for anyone who is not currently on the electoral roll but would like to be. For more information please speak to a churchwarden.
