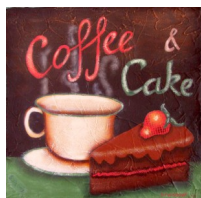
Are you able to help distribute the Vicar's Annual Letter and Gift Day envelope in Bishopthorpe? Please pick up a bundle from the back of church.
